Ensure grades are entered in a timely manner that allows students and parents the ability to monitor progress through parent portal.</p>	<p>Monitor your child's progress in school regularly by contacting staff, scheduling conferences, and using the parent portal. http://parent.mypolkschools.net</p>	<p>Monitor my own progress by asking questions, reviewing feedback from my teachers on returned assignments, and through student portal. Also, talking with my parents and teachers about data to set academic and behavioral goals.</p>
<p>Partnership - Be Involved</p>	<p>Encourage families to participate in school based activities and workshops, as well as volunteering on committees, such as: SAC and PTA. Host activities that gives parents strategies and resources to use at home through agendas.</p>	<p>Participate in decision making about your child's education by volunteering time on parent committees, attending workshops & parent nights. Show positive support for your child's school, teachers, administration, and other staff members.</p>	<p>Request help from my teachers and parents when I do not understand or need help with a problem.
